

Table 3 Summary results for provision of ANG in the districts studied in Cambridgeshire and Peterborough

This shows the percentage of households in each of the ANGSt, eg within 300m of at least a 2 hectare site. The local authorities can be compared against each other and against the county average. It also shows the percentage of households meeting both all and none of the ANGSt.

Key results include:

- 31.6% of households in Cambridge City are within 300m of 2 ha+ ANG. Only 5.4% of households within South Cambridgeshire are within 300m of 2ha+ ANG.
- 91.2% of households in Cambridge City are within 2km of a 20ha+ ANG.
- 91.8 % of households in Peterborough are within 5km of a 100ha+ ANG. There are only 5 households in Fenland within 5km of a 100ha+ ANG.
- East Cambs has 86.6 % of households within 10km of a 500ha+ ANG.
- In Cambridge, Fenland, and South Cambs almost no households meet all the ANGSt.
- 49.5 % of households in Fenland meet none of the ANGSt criteria.
